Mr. Isaac L. Manning, an old negro, has called upon me and asked me to investigate the matter of his father's pension, and I trust that it will not be too much trouble for you to give me what information you have in relation to it.

It seems as if Gato Tredwell, an old negro, was a soldier and served in the Revolutionary War; that he was drawing the sum of \$96.00 a year pension; that he enlisted from Connecticut, and that he had a wife who survived him some 12 years and who never made application for the pension, or at least and in any event she never received any money. This Isaac Manning is very old and I am unable to obtain any further data from him in relation to the matter, however, I have written some letters to some of his relatives from whom I hope to hear further. However, I deem it that your records will be sufficient to give us the required information.

Kindly let me know what, if anything, they show in relation to the matter.
